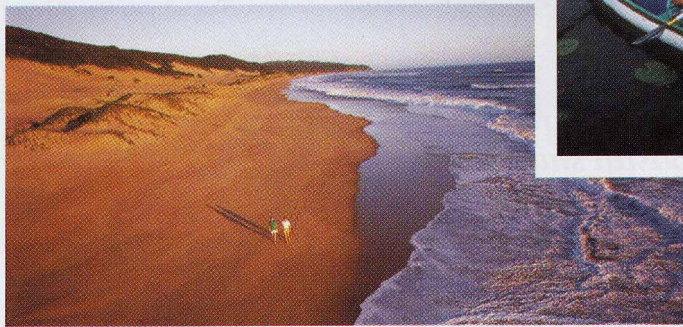
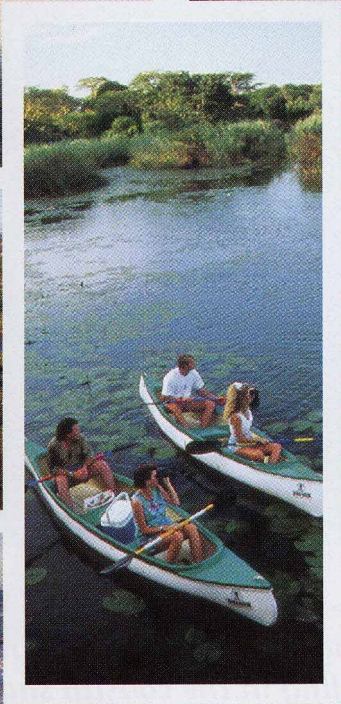
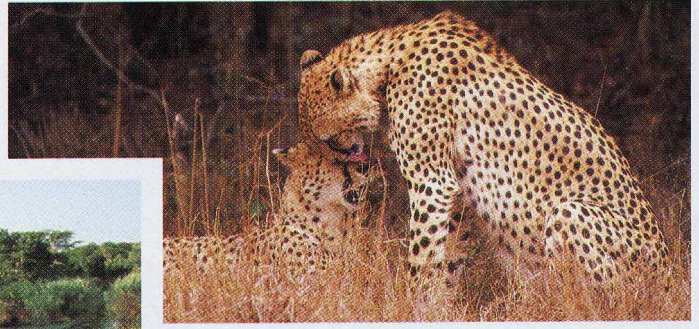


Where seven worlds meet,
